## Notes to Scouts

- Bring a blue merit badge card, **signed by unit leader beneath your address only**, for each merit badge. Counselors **WILL NOT** provide merit badge blue cards.
- If a scout is not properly prepared he may be asked to leave the class. The counselor will decide if a partial completion will be issued.
- **Absolutely no registrations, class changes, or scout substitutions will be accepted at the door.**
