



When – April 17th, 2021. Registration opens at 8 AM, Opening at 9 AM, Lunch at 12 PM, Closing at 4 PM

Who – All Scouting Youth and Adults are encouraged to come to camp for Scoops' Chess Challenge.

Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Venturing Scouts, Explorers, and Sea Scouts are invited for the day and will be broken into age appropriate groupings based on attendance.

Adults are eligible to compete in an adult league.

What - During the morning Boy Scouts are eligible to work on the Chess Merit Badge if they do not already have it. Everyone else can either follow the Boy Scout Chess Merit Badge instruction or play friendly matches (Including 3 way and 4 way chess). In the afternoon a chess tournament will commence. Exact setup will depend on total registrations. The goal is to play as many games as possible. Lunch will be served and light snacks available throughout the day.
