

A \$20,000 award from the Louis and Sally Langie Eagle Scholarship Fund.

Who can Apply?

This grant provides \$5,000 a year for four-years to one college-bound Eagle Scout. Applicant must be currently registered with BSA through the Seneca Waterways Council and either a High School Senior or a High School Graduate who took a gap-year. If you are entering college in Fall 2024 you may apply.

How to Apply

Completed applications, with required documents and a video, can be submitted in <u>one mailed packet</u> to the Service Center, or submitted in <u>one single email</u> to <u>Langieeaglescholarship@senecawaterways.org</u>. The scholarship application is available on the Council's website (Resources/Forms/Eagle Scout Award).

<u>Review eligibility qualifications before you start working on your application. Incomplete</u> <u>applications will be discarded and not considered for review:</u>

- 1. Applicants must be currently registered with a unit in the Seneca Waterways Council, BSA.
- 2. <u>NEW:</u> The scholarship is awarded to one graduating High School Senior who has plans to begin at a 4year college immediately after graduation <u>OR</u> to a High School Graduate who took a gap-year and plans to attend a 4-year college within 15-months of their high school graduation date.
- 3. Academic success is a strong consideration, and a High School Transcript is required. Additional information is required for applicants who took a gap-year.
- 4. Applicants will demonstrate leadership ability in Scouting and provide a record of strong participation in extracurricular activities outside of Scouting.
- 5. Applicants must indicate they have a clear career path and vision to support their college choice and explain how their college studies will help them achieve their career goal.
- 6. Applicants will provide a financial need statement, and the letter must be signed by both the applicant and parents/guardians. Financial need is not the only consideration for selection of the annual recipient.
- 7. Applicant will request a Letter of Recommendation from their Scout Leader or from a Scout volunteer who knows personally knows the Applicant.
- 8. Applicant will prepare and submit a 2-3-minute-long video according to the guidelines provided at the end of this application.
- Email the completed application with the three required documents and video link before <u>May 1, 2024</u>. Mailed applications should include the video on a flash drive.
- 10. Funding will be withdrawn if the applicant does not attend college.

Share special family circumstances such as disabilities, single parent family, ill health of parent, parent job loss, number of siblings, number of siblings in college the years you will attend, etc. Say something other than "college costs a lot of money" or "I want to help my parents." Also share what other arrangements you are pursuing to afford the expense of a college education.

SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

A completed application includes these items:

- A completed application.
- A high school transcript covering six semesters. Home school students will provide equivalents.
- For gap-year applicants: a 400–900 word essay detailing your gap-year.
- A career plan essay.
- A 400–900 word Financial Need Statement, signed by applicant and parent/guardian.
- A letter of recommendation from a Scout Leader or Scout volunteer who knows the applicant.
- A YouTube video link or video on a flash drive.

Check carefully before emailing your completed application. Missing information will lead to disqualification.
