# Cub Scout Update 2024

## Four Areas of Improvements



- One set of requirements is ineffective
- What to do with returning Cub Scouts
- Rank or not a rank?



### **ADVENTURES**

- Disjointed required adventure topics
- Inconsistent number of adventures for each rank
- Volunteers want more elective adventures



### WEBELOS (4TH/5TH GRADE)

- Length of Webelos program
- Does not follow the pattern of other ranks
- · Purpose of the program



### <u>AWARDS</u>

- Awards are not in the direct line of sight of Den Leaders
- Average attachment rate of 1.5%
- Awards do not drive behavior AO

Based on feedback from parents and leaders, these are the areas that BSA has updated and improved the Cub Scout Program. Changes will be implemented June 1, 2024.

## Reimagine Youth Awards into Adventures

Required Adventures have an attachment rate of about 70% (Between 62% and 72%)

Elective Adventures have an attachment rate between 15% - 25%

Awards have an attachment rate of about 1.5% (Between 0% and 3%)



The Summertime Pack Award, as well as other awards, did not have the completion percentage that BSA wanted to see, they believe because they weren't in the direct line of sight of leaders. They have converted them to electives, beltloops rather than patches, to put them in the line of sight of leaders in the Den Meeting Resources.

# PLAN NOW for Summer Time Fun



One Requirement

 Anytime during May through August participate in a total of three Cub Scout activities.

Earning Adventure is not dependent on other's participation.


Summertime Pack Award is now an elective called Summertime Fun. It will earn Scouts an elective for their next rank. For example: 1<sup>st</sup> graders that just completed their Tiger Rank will earn the Summertime Fun beltloop as an elective toward their Wolf Rank.

2024-2025 Cub Scout Badges of Rank The Bobcat Adventure is designed to be the first required Adventure.

Each badge of rank is earned by completing six required and two elective Adventures.

The six required Adventures are focused on the aims and focus areas of the BSA.



All ranks now have 6 required adventures and 2 elective adventures. Note: Bobcat is no longer the first Rank achieved and is now a required adventure at each Rank. This should be the first required adventure completed, if

possible.

# Bobcat Required Adventure Requirements Earned each year, not just once when you first join.

#### LION - KINDERGARTEN

- 1. Get to know the members of your den.
- Have your adult partner or den leader read the Scout Law to you.
   Demonstrate your understanding of being friendly.
- Share with your adult partner, during a den meeting or at home, a time when you have demonstrated the Cub Scout motto "Do Your Best."
- 4. At home, with your parent or legal guardian do the activities in the booklet "How to Protect Your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent's Guide."

#### BEAR - 3RD GRADE

- 1. Get to know members of your den.
- Recite the Scout Oath and Scout Law with your den and den leader.
- Learn about the Scout Oath. Identify the three points of the Scout Oath.
- With your den Create a Den Code of Conduct.
- Learn about the denner position and responsibilities.
- Demonstrate the Cub Scout sign, Cub Scout salute and Cub Scout handshake. Show how each are used.
- Share with your den, or family, a time when you demonstrated the Cub Scout motto "Do Your Best." Explain why it is important to do your best.
- 8. At home, with your parent or legal guardian do the activities in the booklet "How to Protect Your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent's Guide."

#### ARROW OF LIGHT - 5TH GRADE

- Learn about the patrol method and discuss the benefits.
- 2. Choose a Patrol name and elect a patrol leader.
- Make a patrol flag that includes everyone's name.
- Recite the Scout Oath and Scout Law with your patrol.
- With your patrol develop a Code of Conduct.
- Demonstrate the Scouts BSA sign, salute, and handshake. Show how each is used.
- With your patrol or with your parent/legal guardian visit a Scouts BSA Troop.
- 8. At home, with your parent or legal guardian do the activities in the booklet "How to Protect Your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent's Guide." AB

Bobcat requirements are age appropriate and build on each other. Bobcat is now a required adventure and will be completed each year.

# Badges of Rank and Adventures

Current Cub Scouts do not need to change their uniform.

Lion – Bear badges of rank position on the uniform is based on the order earned.



This is the suggested wearing of earned ranks, without Bobcat Rank Badge. Scouts who have already earned the Bobcat Rank Badge can continue to wear it.

There will not be an Arrow of Light Hat or Neckerchief.

Changes to Webelo and AOL Uniforms: Webelo (4<sup>th</sup> Grade) will remain in blue shirts and wear their recently earned Bear rank. AOL (5<sup>th</sup> Grade) will transition to Scouts BSA Tan shirts and wear their Webelo Rank on their left shirt pocket. AOL Dens may choose to do what Troops in Scouts BSA do and choose a color and make their own Neckerchief.

# Webelos and Arrow of Light Uniform




Switching to a Scouts BSA Tan uniform is ultimately a decision made by the family.

 When the family has decided that they will cross over into Scouts BSA and the blue Cub Scout uniform no longer fits.



Collaboration with National Scouts BSA Committee

The complete Arrow of Light badge or rank is designed to prepare for Scouts BSA not just one Adventure.

Designed to have Arrow of Light Cub Scouts joining a Scouts BSA Troop by January/February.

No duplication of requirements between Arrow of Light and Scout Rank.

The goal of the Arrow of Light Program is to prepare the Scouts for the transition to Scouts BSA. They will operate in a way that is similar to the way a Patrol operates at the Troop level.





As of August 2024 Lion/Tiger Handbooks cost \$12.99

Lion and Tiger Handbooks will come packaged with and Adult Partner Book to give them the resources to lead and help at home.



#### REQUIREMENTS


- Show how to properly wear a bicycle helmet. Show you can take it off and put it on without help.

- With your den, pack, or family, following the buddy system, take a bike ride.


